- a) The Inspection Team consists of **Dr. Munir Ahmed & Dr. V. Guruprasad**, Professors, Government Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Bangalore visited the concern Institution on 25-04-2017 and Submitted the report on **26-04-2017**. The Inspection team recommended to for starting of Homoeopathic Medical College. Hence, the permission may be granted to start the New Homoeopathic Medical College with the name of **Yenepoya Homoeopathy Medical College & Hospital, Mangalore**. The College is attached with 25 bedded **Yenepoya Homoeopathy Medical College & Hospital, Mangalore** which was established in the year 2015.

- b) It is desirable to establish an Homoeopathic College in the public interest and starting a new BHMS Degree course with an intake capacity of 100 seats.
- c) Establishment of Homoeopathic college and starting BHMS Degree course at **Yenepoya Homoeopathy Medical College & Hospital, Mangalore** by Government of Karnataka is feasible.

It is also certified that adequate clinical material as per norms of the Central Council of Homoeopathy is available with the existing medical college. It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the Homoeopathy college as per Central Council of Homoeopathy norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the state Government shall take over the responsibilities of the students already admitted in the Colleges with permission of the central Government.
